Board to spruce up Pope Avenue

The Hilton Head Island Board of Realtors will attempt to raise \$10,000 by the end of May for sprucing up Pope Avenue and the Sea Pines Circle.

Last week Jim Richardson, board president, presented a check for \$100 to Corey Price, chairman of the committee that will leading the drive.

Price, a realtor with Hilton Head Island Realty, explained that the National Board of Realtors each year announces a theme and encourages local boards to adopt a project using that theme. This year's theme is "Make America Better."

The committee, which also includes Vic Saxe, Cliff Baggett and Jim Smith, has decided to

help the Pope Avenue Beautification Committee in its continuing efforts to improve the landscaping and maintenance of the Sea Pines Circle-Pope Avenue area, Price explained.

In addition to purchasing trees, bushes and flowering shrubs, the committee also intends to erect a sign that would be appropriate for community announcements. The sign, which would stand at the Sea Pines Circle, would be an alternative to temporary signs which many organizations erect there to announce a coming event—and often neglect to remove afterwards.

All members of the Board of Realtors will be asked to con-

tribute to the campaign. After the donations have been tallied, each real estate firm on the island will be asked to match the amount given by its agents.
